

HONOUR OUR VETERANS BANNER PROGRAM

The Lumsden Legion branch is proud to announce the Honour Our Veterans Banner Program.

This program is designed to create a lasting legacy of remembrance and honour within our community that will enable our residents and visitors to pay tribute to our veterans. Honourees can be any man or woman who served Canada or her allies, in war, on a peacekeeping mission, in the Cold War, and at peacetime. Plus any active servicemembers including those in the RCMP. They could have also served in the military, the merchant marine, or in the nursing and other medical corps during wartime.

The honouree should have some connection to the Lumsden area (born here, grew up here, lived here, or related to a current resident), or be a First Nations veteran from our surrounding area.

The program is open to any member of the public wishing to honour a veteran.

If you don't know of anyone personally but still want to sponsor a banner, we here at the Legion may be able to choose an appropriate local veteran for you.

For participation in the Honour Our Veterans Banner Program, please submit this application form, along with a sponsorship cheque OR E-transfer of \$300.00 and a high resolution 5"x7" portrait-style photograph of the service person (Headshot and uniform preferred, but not necessary)

Although hardcopy pictures are preferable and are most often the best image for the banner, a digital photo in PDF or similar format of 300 DPI or better (high resolution) will work if a paper copy is not available. It can be emailed to d.s.crofts@sasktel.net OR dan@croftelectric.com

The cheque should be made payable to: Royal Canadian Legion - Lumsden Branch #234

All applications will be taken on a first-come, first-served basis. The sponsorship will cover the placement of the banner for up to five years as long as it remains in good repair. After five years, or when normal wear and tear prevents its display, sponsors will have the option to replace it.

PHOTOGRAPH: Please include a high resolution 5"x7" portrait-style photo of the servicemember in uniform with identification written on the back. A digital photo in PDF or similar format of 300 dpi or better may be acceptable if it is of a very high resolution. It can be emailed to any of the addresses below.
